

An open letter to the Treasurer, Hon Josh Frydenberg MP

Monday 14th October 2019

Dear Treasurer

We, the undersigned, request that an additional term of reference be included in the recently announced Review of the Retirement Incomes System to explicitly focus on the significant and worsening issue of the economic insecurity of women in retirement.

The systemic, structural, economic, social and demographic drivers of the gender retirement gap have been well documented, and mean that:

- women have been retiring with on average just over half the superannuation savings of men;
- increasing numbers of women are experiencing poverty in retirement;
- single retired women are the fastest growing cohort of the homeless; and
- one in three women has no superannuation and one in four women retire with no superannuation.

Adding such a term of reference will ensure that there is specific gender analysis of current and alternate policy settings and will ensure that resulting policy making will improve retirement outcomes for women.

Improving retirement outcomes for women should be a specific objective of the review.
